This very popular event should be interesting -- especially since the kumu is even scarcer and all fish have a minimum of 12" fork length. Following the weigh in that evening is the great Chinese Banquet (including freshly caught fish) with the awards and lots of prizes.

ELIMINATIONS 2004 The concept was reveiwed at the last Exec board meeting and will be following last years general format. There should a good draft and more details at the time of the Kumu Hunt and with follow-up mailings.

MONTH OF DECEMBER is Christmas and Family time with no special events planned. However, Happy New Year in January 2004 and we start off with - DA TAKO HUNT!

TAKO HUNT - Sunday January 25th, 2004. This allows all divers to get a good start with the New Year.. and in most cases if you can see a good size Hee', then it should not require as much skill to capture this camouflage creature. You can go anywhere but be at my house for the weigh in by 2 PM or win a DQ. There will be 9 prizes covering this event.... Including total weight = 3 largest, heaviest single tako, and the longest tako. Minimum weight is 2 pounds and no scooping in the tako category. There will be an award for the "Mystery Fish" category -- and caught with a 3 prong, 12 inch minimum size, at the fork. Fish to be considered are any blue water fish, awa, uku and jack family. You can have only one fish...and on the table at Mystery drawing time that will determine the specie. If more than one is on the table, the heaviest wins. This is a fun tournament and is open to any interested person...so invite your friends to join in . Application and entry fee of \$15 by Thursday January 22nd and if after that date the fee is \$20. DUES..2004 .. As usual the dues that allow your club to function is for the calendar year. and you can mail in (\$30 single--\$40 Family) or include with your payment if you are entering the Kumu Hunt or Tako Hunt. Remember the benefits not only include membership and activities, but so far every year was the free admission to the annual teahouse Christmas Party. Of course you should also consider the Underwater Society of America \$15. (a must if you are to compete in the US Nationals). This years Nationals will be in Hawaii and possibly will include men, women and mixed teams.

DATE & PLACE; SUNDAY - November 23rd sunrise till weigh-in. Open to all Oahu shores.

ENTRY FEE: \$30.00 Per diver to cover awards, pupus and banquet. \$15.00 For each guest attending the banquet.

SCORING: 1. Weigh masters, Dennis Okada and Frank Farm

- 2. Only goat fish will count towards trophies.
- 3. You may shoot as many you want, but only 3 largest goats will be weighed for score.
- 4. Scoring by total weight No points per fish. A tie decided by total length.
- 5. Pananuu, papio and toau will be weighed individually. Prizes awarded.
- 6. All fish 12 inches to fork minimum

AWARDS: 1. Total weight - champion, 2nd and 3rd place.

- 2. Largest goatfish., champion, 2nd and 3rd place
- 3. Special prizes for largest papio (under 10 lbs.), pananuu and toau.
- 4. There will be no scooping of more that two awards per diver, one for goats and one for special categories.

DIVE RULES: 1. No boats, kayaks, motorized propulsion or scuba.

- 2. All entries must be from shorelines of Oahu.
- 3. No use of lights of any form. (Underwater lights)
- 4. No gang banging of fish. (Sharing spears is OK)
- 5. Fish lost due to bad shot is fair game to all other divers.
- 6. No mutilated fish will be score.
- 7. Cheaters will be disqualified.
- 8. All divers must weigh their fish.
- 9. Judge's decision is final. (Weigh master)

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS Dive with a buddy !! (For his safety)

: Divers required to use a dive flag & recommended to carry a dive knife.

Each diver is responsible for safety - don't dive somewhere you can't handle or don't know. Weigh - in will not begin until all divers are accounted for. If you are unable to be back in time please call in at Frank's house. (732-1756)
